

## Civil Rights Restoration Lobby Day Instructions

**Parking:** Boston Common Garage located at 1 Charles Street. Follow the signs inside of the garage to the south west elevator, then walk west up Beacon Street, take a left onto Bowdoin Street, enter State House Park (you will see the memorials) straight ahead you will see the entrance to the State House

**Commuter Rail:** South Station – Start on Atlantic Ave, take a left onto Summer St, take a right onto Tremont St, take a left onto Park St, take a right onto Beacon St, take a left onto Bowdoin Street, enter State House Park (you will see the memorials) straight ahead you will see the entrance to the State House

**North Station** – Start on Causeway St, take a left onto Staniford St, take a left onto Derne St, go up the stairs into State House Park and there you can enter the State House on the right

When entering the building you will have to pass through security; make sure to NOT bring any knives, firearms, pepper spray or signs of any kind, as those items are prohibited inside of the building.

The State House Café has been closed, but there are some vending machines around the building. However, it is a good idea to bring your own snacks and water to avoid having to leave and re-enter the State House.

When you get into the building, take the elevator to the third floor and follow the signs to the House Chamber, GOAL Staff will be at the benches with instructions and informational materials.
